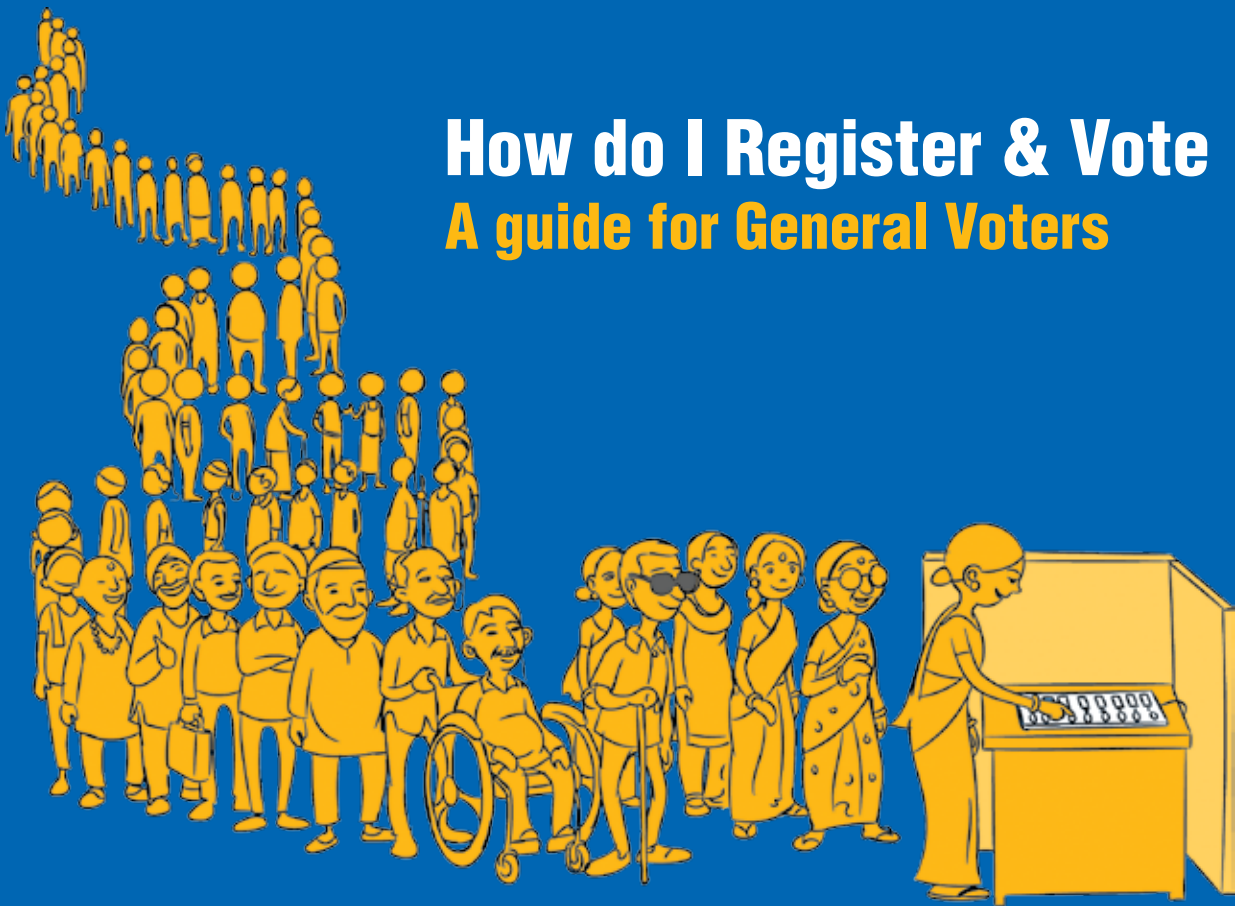


How do I Register & Vote

You can enroll as a General Voter if you are



⚙ An Indian citizen



⚙ 18 years of age on 1st January



⚙ Resident of polling area



⚙ Not disqualified

Who is not qualified to be enrolled in the Electoral Roll

⚙ Not a citizen of India



⚙ Of unsound mind

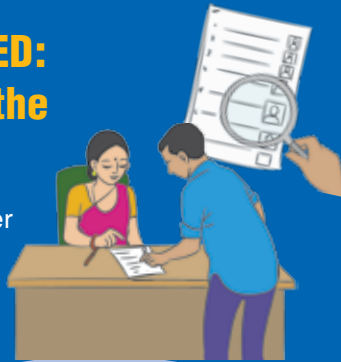


⚙ Disqualified from voting due to specified corrupt practices or offenses relating to elections



GETTING STARTED: Registration in the Electoral Roll

Enrol as a General Voter



Collect **Form 6** from
Electoral Registration
Officer (ERO) or Booth
Level Officer (BLO)

Fill **Form 6**



OR

Download **Form 6**, fill 2 copies and
submit to ERO

OR

Fill **Form 6 online** on **www.nvsp.in**
and upload required documents



OR

Send by Post

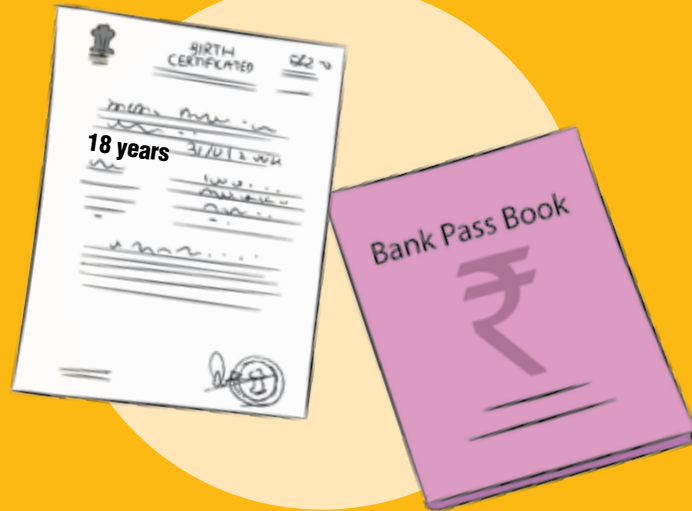


Passport size colour photo

Photo-copies of documentary proof of age and residence



Documentary proof of age for ages 18 to 21. For other cases, declaration of age by applicant is required



EPIC – Electors Photo Identity Card

Booth Level Officer visits address



If form is accepted,
BLO delivers EPIC or
calls you to office



If you have shifted home:

- Same constituency- fill **Form 8A** online or download and submit to the ERO/ AERO of the area
- Different constituency- fill **Form 6** online or download **Form 6** and submit



If you want to change address in EPIC, make a payment of Rs. 25 with an application to Electoral Registration Officer of the new constituency. The new EPIC address will carry the same EPIC number as the old one.

How to make modifications or corrections in your entries in the electoral roll

For correction of mistakes in electoral roll, fill **Form 8 online** or download the **Form 8** and submit to the ERO/ AERO.

What is Form 7?

Application for objecting inclusion of or deleting a name from the electoral roll. You have to be registered as a voter to fill this form.

Deletion/Objection of inclusion/exclusion of name from electoral roll if:

- ☞ Person has shifted residence
- ☞ Known person is dead
- ☞ Not eligible for other reasons

Where?

- ☞ File application with the Electoral Registration Officer or Assistant Electoral Registration Officer of the constituency
- OR**
- ☞ Submit online

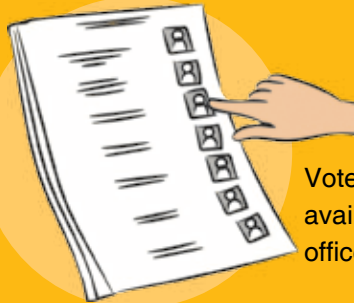
How?

- ☞ Give details of person whose name has to be deleted/objection for inclusion of name
- ☞ Give your details
- ☞ Give your detailed address
- ☞ Reasons for deletion/objection
- ☞ Declaration that facts mentioned are correct



Casting your Valuable Vote

Check your name on the Voter List which is available on the website of Chief Electoral Officer

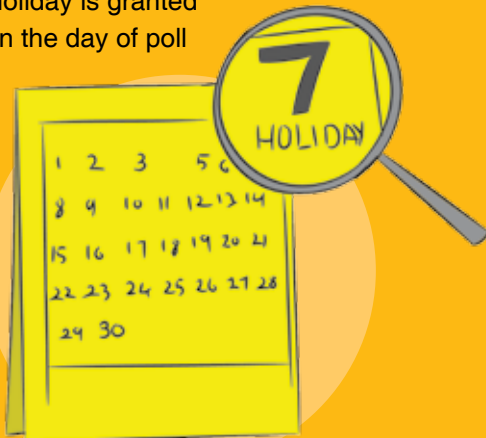


Voter list is also available in the office of ERO



Gadgets not allowed inside a polling booth

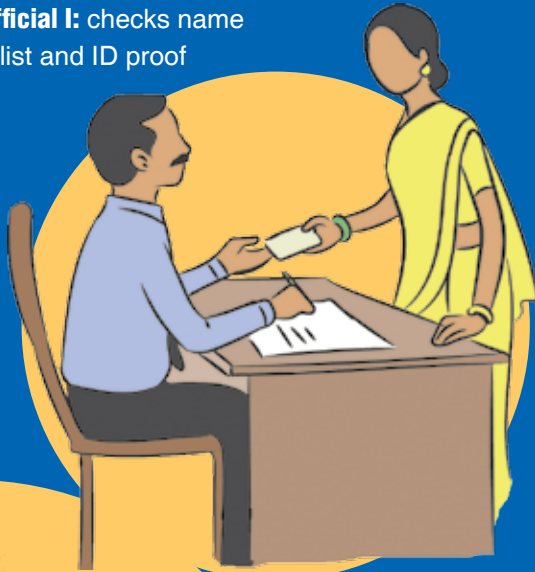
Holiday is granted on the day of poll



Stand in queue. Keep ID and the voter slip ready



Polling official I: checks name on voter list and ID proof



Polling official II: inks finger, gives chit and takes your signature



Polling official III: takes chit and checks your finger



press button to vote on the Electronic Voting Machine; you hear a beep sound

Press NOTA if you don't like any candidate



KEEPING IN MIND: Points to Remember

Check your name on the electoral roll ahead of election on the website of the Chief Electoral Officer of your state – Having an EPIC does not guarantee you a vote, having the name on Electoral Roll is a must

Help Line - Call 1950 during elections to get any information related to enrolment and voting

No person can be enrolled in more than one electoral roll; so while getting yourself enrolled at the new place of residence get your name deleted from the electoral roll of old assembly constituency

Founded in 1950, the **Election Commission of India** conducts the entire process of elections to the office of the President, Vice President, Parliament and the State Assemblies. In the performance of its functions ECI not only prepares, maintains and periodically updates the Electoral Rolls, supervises the nominations of candidates, registers political parties, monitors the election campaigns and funding of candidates, but also ensures active and aware electoral participation of the second largest population in the world through its SVEEP programme.

The Constitution of India grants its every eligible citizen, regardless of gender, religion, caste, education, socio economic status or location - a right to vote and every vote carries the same value. Hence, it becomes imperative for all citizens to actively partake in the electoral process, ensuring many other rights by utilizing the right to vote.

Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) is a programme to educate citizens, electors and voters about the electoral process and to enhance
