

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

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Role of SO

Postal Ballot

Coordinating the segregation of poll and training/awareness EVM-VVPATs through 1st Randomization in presence of political parties.

Awareness on EVM-VVPAT.

EVM (Ballot Unit + Control Unit + VVPAT)



Ballot Unit

VVPAT

Control Unit

- EVM consists of Ballot Unit, Control Unit and VVPAT
- Polling Officer presses the Ballot Button of Control Unit which enable the voter to cast his vote using Ballot Unit
- When a voter presses a button against the candidate of his choice in Ballot Unit, red light glow against candidate of his choice in Ballot Unit.
- A paper slip showing the serial no, name and the symbol of the candidate of his choice is generated and visible for about 7 seconds through transparent window of VVPAT

Control Unit



CONTROL UNIT- enables the Ballot Unit to accept vote from the voter and stores the vote cast

Ballot Unit



BALLOT UNIT- the voter can franchise his/her vote by pressing a button against the candidate of his/her choice

Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT)



VVPAT- allows the voters to verify that their votes are cast as intended.

CEC- S L Shakdar talked about introducing an Electronic machine.

EVMs developed and demonstrated by ECIL and BEL.

EVMs used first time in 50 polling stations of Parur AC in Kerala. And then in 11 Assembly Constituencies: 8 states, 1UT.

SC suspends EVM usage: cannot be used till RP Act is amended.

RP Act amended: enabling use EVMs w.e.f. 15.03.1989.

EVM has been used continuously since 2000

SC dismissed petition asking for return to Ballot papers!

In All Political Party Meeting held on 04.10.2021 agreed to incorporate VVPAT with EVM

SC allowed ECI to introduced VVPAT system in phased manner

In all party meeting, the Commission committed to ensure 100% coverage of VVPATs in all future elections.

100% deployment of VVPATs in Lok Sabha 2019.

SC directions for verification of VVPAT slips of 5 polling stations per AC or AS in a PC for greater satisfaction.

Since 2000, EVMs have been used in all elections: 4 Lok Sabha and 132 State Legislative Assemblies. Till date, >340 crore votes cast on EVMs.



DOUBTS CREATED AROUND EVM



EVM CHALLENGE- 2009

- Commission organized an EVM Challenge w.e.f. 3rd 8th August 2009.
- Political Parties, Petitioners before various Courts and some individuals, who had alleged tamperability of ECI-EVM, invited to participate in the Challenge.
- 100 EVM brought from 10 States were offered for demonstration of alleged tamperability in presence of technical expert group, representative of manufacturers and ECI Officers.
- None of the persons could actually demonstrate any tamperability of the ECI-EVM.

EVM CHALLENGE- 2017

- Commission organized an EVM Challenge on 3rd June 2017.
- All National and State Political Parties invited to participate in the Challenge.
- Parties given opportunity to demonstrate EVM manipulation/tampering in the votes recorded in the EVMs of their choice, as variously alleged earlier.
- Only 2 parties i.e. NCP & CPI-M reported to venue, ONLY TO UNDERSTAND THE EVM PROCESS BETTER and were given detailed briefing.
- The credibility and integrity of ECI-EVMs has always remained perfectly intact and unscathed.

We Should Know!

- Since the introduction of VVPATs, more than 113 crore voters have cast their votes with full satisfaction & ONLY 25 (twenty-five) complaints received u/r 49MA, which were all FOUND TO BE FALSE.
- Till date, in **61 (Sixty-one)** instances RO has allowed slip counting since 2017. **All counts matched.**
- In Mandatory Verification of VVPAT slips count no case of a vote cast for Candidate 'A' getting transferred to candidate 'B'.



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

ECI Press Note Point 24. District, AC Level and Booth Level Election Management Plan

 The District Election Officers have been asked to prepare a comprehensive District Election Management Plan in consultation with SSPs/SPs and Sector Officers, including the route plan and the communication plan for conduct of elections.

 These will be vetted by the Observer, taking into account vulnerability mapping exercise and mapping of critical polling stations, in accordance with Election Commission of India's extant instructions

Co-ordination & Co-operation



ECI Press Note Point 25 Communication Plan

- Commission attaches great importance to preparation and implementation of a perfect communication plan at the district/constituency level for the smooth conduct of elections and to enable concurrent intervention and mid-course correction on the poll day.
- Coordination with the officers of Telecommunication Department in the State headquarters, BSNL/MTNL authorities, the representatives of other leading service providers in the State so that network status in the State is assessed and communication shadow areas be identified.
- Make suitable alternate arrangements in the communication shadow areas by providing Satellite Phones, Wireless sets, Special Runners etc

ECI Press Note 29 & 30. Law and Order, Security Arrangements and Deployment of Forces

- 29. To ensure optimum and effective utilization of State Police official and CAPF, Commission has directed that a committee of CEO, State Police Nodal Officer and State CAPF Coordinate to jointly decide the Election Security Plan and ensure randomization of State Police and CAPF personnel.

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ECI Press Note 31 EEM

- 31. Election Expenditure Monitoring-
 - As per revised limits, pertinent to these 5 elections, the limit on candidate expenditure for the states of Punjab, Uttarakhand and UP will now be Rs 40 lakhs and for Goa and Manipur it shall be Rs 28 lakhs.
 - Effective monitoring of the election expenditure of the candidates have been issued, which include formation of Flying Squads (FS), Static Surveillance Teams (SST), Video Surveillance Teams (VST), involvement of State Police, Investigation Directorate of Income Tax Deptt., Enforcement Directorate, Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU-IND), DRI, RPF, CBIC, SSB, ICG, Commercial Tax Department and Narcotics Control Bureau. S



USE OF MONEY POWER

Without money, multi-party democracy cannot function But 'Money Power' involves certain risks:


- Uneven playing field and lack of fair competition.
- Political exclusion certain sectors face disadvantage.
- Co-opted politicians under campaign debts act as pressure group to influence policy of government
- Tainted governance and Rule of Law undermined
- Excessive, illegal & illegitimate expenditure in elections is one of the root causes of corruption.

TYPES OF ELECTION EXPENDITURE

Election expenditure can be classified into two types on the basis of legal provisions



Illegal expenditure [Distribution of money, gifts, liquor or any other item among electors and expenditure on Paid News]



Rule 90 of the CE Rules, 1961 AC-₹ 40 lakhs for Punjab, UP, Uttarakhand and 28 lakhs for Goa & Manipur Such type of expenditure by candidates needs to be stopped

Sec 77(1): Account of Election Expenses and maximum thereof

- •Candidate shall keep a separate, correct account of election expenditure
- •Between date of nomination & date of declaration of results

Expln. 1(a) of Sec 77(1): Leaders of a Political party(Star Campaigners)

•Expenses of star campaigners on travel are exempt.

Expln. 2 of Sec 77(1) (Star Campaigners)

- •For recognised parties- 30 names.
- •For unrecognized parties- 15 names
- •To be communicated to the ECI and CEOs of the States
- •Within a period of 7 days from the date of notification.

MAJOR LEGAL PROVISIONS RP Act, 1951

Sec 78: Lodging of account with District Election Officer

•Account of candidate to be deposited with DEO within 30 days from the date of declaration of result.

Sec 10A: Disqualification for failure to lodge account of election expense

- •Failure to lodge an account of election expenses within time and manner required by law and has no good reason or justification for the failure
- •Disqualification for a period of three years from the date of order of the Commission

Instructions of ECI- updated Compendium

- It contains structure of and functions of various constituents of Election Expenditure Monitoring mechanism.
- Also contains role of RO, DEO, CEOs along with checklist.
- Commission's instructions on monitoring of expenditure is provided chronologically alongwith SOPs for various enforcement agencies.

ROLE OF DEO-RATE LIST

The list of rates of items for use in electioneering to be given to the candidates at the time of filing of nomination papers

If the rate of any item is not available in the list, the candidate/election agent, if they so wish, may apply to the DEOs to notify the rates for such items. The DEOs will take appropriate steps to notify them

Any objection regarding the quantum of such rates has to be made to the DEO within 24 hours of notification

To obtain airing charges from media houses with reference to campaigning through electronic media

There can be different rates for rural and urban areas in a state.

हाईकोर्ट का सवाल... डॉक्टर का ट्रांसफर कैसे निरस्त कर सकता है निर्वाचन आयोग

जयपर | हाईकोर्ट ने एक डॉक्टर के ट्रांसफर को निरस्त करने के मामले में निर्वाचन आयोग व राज्य सरकार को जवाब के लिए समय देते हुए पूछा है कि आयोग ट्रांसफर को कैसे निरस्त कर सकता है। वहीं अदालत ने आयोग द्वारा प्रार्थी के ट्रांसफर निरस्त करने के आदेश पर भी रोक लगा दी है। जस्टिस अरूण भंसाली ने यह निर्देश डॉ.नटवर कुमार स्वर्णकार की याचिका पर दिया। अधिवक्ता राजेन्द्र सोनी ने बताया कि चिकित्सा विभाग ने 14 अगस्त को प्रार्थी का ट्रांसफर सवाई माधोपुर से जयपुर किया था। प्रार्थी ने जिला निर्वाचन अधिकारी की अनुमित लेकर कार्यभार भी संभाल लिया, लेकिन 17 अगस्त को राज्य निर्वाचन आयोग ने आदर्श आचार संहिता का हवाला देते हुए प्रार्थी सहित 340 अन्य चिकित्सकों के ट्रांसफर निरस्त कर दिए।

165 करोड़ रुपए की पेयजल परियोजना का शिलान्यास आज

जयपुर. मुख्यमंत्री अशोक गहलोत की बजट घोषणा के अनुसार जयपुर शहर के लिए बनी 165 करोड़ रुपए की पेयजल परियोजना बुधवार को धरातल पर उतरेगी।

हवामहल विधायक महेश जोशी बुधवार को इस परियोजना को पूरा करने के लिए बनाए गए आठ पैकेज में से तीन पैकेज के तहत स्वीकृत कार्यों का शुभारंभ करेंगे। उत्तर सर्कल एसई अजय सिंह राठौंड ने बताया कि पैकेज के तहत बेनीवाल बाग में 20 लाख लीटर का स्वच्छ जलाशय, बह्मपुरी पीएचईडी कार्यालय परिसर में 20 लाख लीटर का उच्च जलाशय, 50 लाख लीटर का स्वच्छ जलाशय, संट्रीफयूगल पंप

बदलने का कार्य, परियोजना के तहत ही इन क्षेत्रों में पानी का प्रेशर बढ़ाने के लिए 9 किलोमीटर से ज्यादा की फीडर मैन पाइप लाइन बिछाई जाएगी।

इस परियोजना के पूरा होने के बाद ब्रह्मपुरी, गोविंद नगर, गुर्जर घाटी व आसपास के क्षेत्रों में रह रही डेढ़ लाख की आबादी लाभान्वित होगी।

भुगतान नहीं मिला तो काम बंद करेंगे पीडब्ल्यूडी ठेकेदार

जयपुर पीडब्लूडी ठेकेदारों ने भुगतान नहीं करने पर काम बंद करने की चेतावनी दी है। ठेकेदारों की पीडब्लडी पर दो साल से करीब 1300 करोड से अधिक की राशि बकाया चल रही है। ठेकेदार दो साल से बकाया राशि का भुगतान करने को लेकर धरना-प्रदर्शन कर रहे थे। इसके बाद सरकार ने करीब 400 करोड़ का तो भुगतान कर दिया, लेकिन करीब 300 करोड रुपए अब भी बकाया चल रहे हैं। यह राशि सिविल, इलेक्ट्रिक सहित अन्य एसोसिएशन की है। राजस्थान वर्क कॉन्ट्रेक्टर एसोसिएशन अध्यक्ष राम सिंह ने बताया कि सिविल वर्क का पीडब्लूडी पर करीब 1100 करोड़ से अधिक की राशि बकाया चल रही है। भूगतान नहीं होने से ठेकेदारों की हालत खराब है। परिवार का खर्चा चलाना मुश्किल हो रहा है।

ECI Press Note (Point 26)

26. Model Code of Conduct-

Model Code of Conduct comes into effect immediately from the announcement of schedule. All the provisions of the Model Code will apply to the whole of Goa, Manipur, Punjab Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh with regard to all candidates, political parties and the governments of the said States. The Model Code of Conduct shall also be applicable to the Union Government in so far as announcements/policy decisions pertaining to/for Goa, Manipur, Punjab Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh are concerned.

The Commission has made elaborate arrangements for ensuring the effective implementation of MCC Guidelines. Any violation of these Guidelines would be strictly dealt with and the Commission re-emphasizes that the instructions issued in this regard from time to time should be read and understood by all Political Parties, contesting candidates and their agents/representatives, to avoid any misgivings or lack of information or inadequate understanding/interpretation. The Governments of the pollbound States have also been directed to ensure that no misuse of official machinery/position is done during the MCC period.

The Commission has also issued instructions for swift, effective and stringent action for enforcement of Model Code of Conduct during the first 72 hours of announcement of the election schedule and also for maintaining extra vigilance and strict enforcement action in the last 72 hours prior to the close of polls. These instructions have been issued in the form of Standard


Operating Procedures (SOPs) for compliance by the field election machinery.

Do's & Don'ts

The list of dos' and don'ts' is only illustrative and not exhaustive and is not intended to substitute or modify other detailed directions/instructions on the above subjects, which must be strictly observed and followed.

Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) at polling stations

Election Commission has directed that voter friendly facilities and amenities should be provided at polling stations.

The following Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) to be checked at each polling station:-

- Permanent Ramps with hand rail
- Provision for drinking water
- Separate Toilet for Men & Women
- Electricity
- Adequate furniture
- Proper signage
- Shades
- Separate Entry and Exit
- Help Desk
- Good Approach Road

Note:- This will be further supplemented with COVID mitigation measures like sanitizers, thermal scanner, soap etc., as notified from time to time.

Polling station to have a minimum area of 20 sq. meters so that there is no congestion inside the polling station .

Maximum distance to be covered by an elector to be not more than 2 km.

Separate queues for men and women.

Old, infirm, pregnant women and differently abled persons (PWD) should be allowed to enter the polling station without having to stand in the queue.

Verify whether route plotted on map is feasible - Ascertaining the approach and accessibility.

Ensure that wide publicity is given to new polling stations.

Voter Facilitation Poster

In order to fulfil the statutory requirements under Rule 310f the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961 and to provide accurate and relevant information for voter awareness and information at each polling station, the Commission directs that uniform and standardized Voter Facilitation Posters (VFP) following total of FOUR (4) kind of Posters shall be prominently displayed at all Polling Stations i.e.

- 1. Polling Station Details,
- 2. List of Candidates,
- 3. Do's and Don'ts and
- 4. Approved Identification Documents & How to Vote
- Additionally COVID Awareness behavior posters too.

Voter **Assistance**

Voter Assistance Booths shall be set up for every polling station location, having a team of BLO/officials in order **Booths** (VAB) to assist voters to correctly locate her /his polling booth number and serial number in the electoral roll of that concerned polling booth. The VABs will be set up with prominent signage and in such a manner that it will be conspicuous to the

- voters as they approach the polling premise/building to enable them to seek required facilitation on poll day.
- Alphabetic locator (as per English alphabet) generated with ERO Net is placed at VAB to search the name easily and to know the serial number in the Electoral Roll.

Standardized Voting Compartment

In order to maintain the secrecy of vote at the time of poll and to achieve uniformity in use of voting compartments, Commission revised its instructions on 15th November, 2016 and height of the Voting the increase Compartments to 30 inches and also directed that the Voting Compartment should be placed on a table whose height shall be 30 inches. Only corrugated plastic sheet (flex board) of steel-grey colour, which completely opaque and reusable, shall be used for making the voting compartments.

Different Categories of Beneficiaries

Service Voter (including wife if ordinarily residing with him) except those Classified Service Voters, who opted for proxy voting (Rule 17A)

Special Voters - (including wife if ordinarily residing with them) who are holding declared offices. [List of such declared offices is given in footnote below Sec. 20 of RP Act, 1950] (Rule 17b)

Voters on election duty (Rule 17C)

Notified voters – In special circumstances such class of persons as is notified by ECI under Sec. 60 (c) of RP Act 1951.

Absentee voters (defined in Rule 27A) – Senior Citizens (8o+), PwD and Covid Positive

Special Note

For absentee voter, it is only an additional facility and they can visit polling stations and vote personally or apply to avail postal ballot facility.

Voters who have been issued PB are not entitled to vote at polling station.

Distribution and collection of 12D by BLO within five days of Declaration

RO draws list of all Absentee Voters in the 3 categories, i.e. (a) 'AVSC', (b) 'AVPD' and (c) AVCO, whose applications have been received in time and are in order The RO shall also indicate entry 'PB' in the marked copy after issuing PB to the absentee voter

The team of 2 polling officials, Micro-observers, Videographer, Police official shall visit the electors at the address mentioned in their application Form 12D for facilitating their voting by postal ballot paper.

The electors are intimated, in advance, about the date and approximate time of visit of poll officials, through SMS. The intimation is also given by post and lor through the BLO.

A tick mark shall be placed against the name of the elector in the list of AVSC, AVPD and AVCO to indicate that the person has voted. The counterfoil with the serial number and part number elector duly filled up shall be got detached and

The electors are intimated, in advance, about the date and time approximate of visit of poll officials, through SMS. The intimation is also given by post andlor through the BLO.

Poll officer is authorized to attest with his full name and designation 'poll officer', the declaration in Form 13A in the case of AVSC, AVPD and AVCO. In the case of a **COVID** affected person on in treatment Hospital, the Medical Officer attending to the person also authorized to

At the end of each day of visit by poll officers to the address of AVSC/AVPD/AVCO electors, the envelopes in Form-12C containing postal ballot paper etc. and the counterfoils of ballot papers containing the signature/thumb impression of electors and other particulars, shall be collected by the ARO designated of postal voting by the absentee voters.

Important

✓ Visits by teams of poll officers to the address of AVSC, AVPD and AVCO electors should be planned in such a way that the same is completed 1 day prior to the date fixed for poll in the constituency.

✓ For the poll officers deputed to AVCO electors appropriate protection equipment including PPE kit shall be provided. This should be done in consultation with the Nodal Health Officer for AVCOs.
